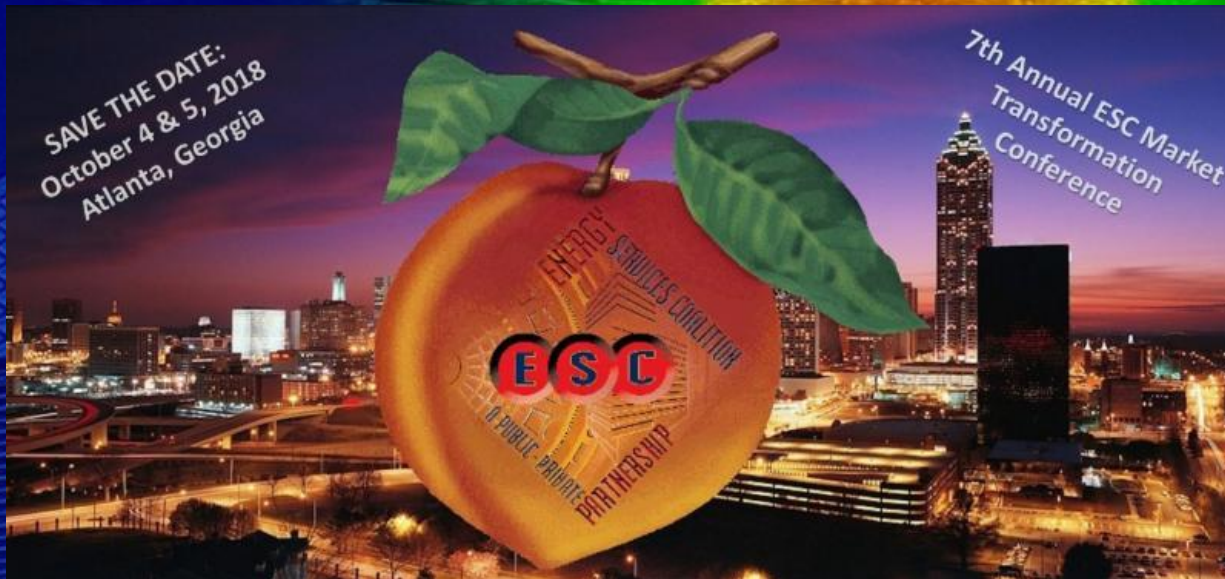

Race to the Top Goes Over \$10 billion in Lead-up to 7th Annual Conference

The ESC's Race to the Top database recently surpassed \$10 billion in projects reported by the states or gathered from publicly available resources

Since 2012 the ESC has awarded its [Race to the Top](#) award at its annual conference. The Race to the Top is part of the ESC's continuing effort to broaden the demonstration of national non-federal GESPC investment results tracked to date and how each state's achievement compares in dollars per capita.

Past efforts have proven helpful in not only identifying existing or past users of GESPC and charting past achievements, but also for instilling credibility and acceptance of GESPC as a resource. This year's data collection effort, supported by the U.S. Department of Energy's Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy, will recognize both the overall (multi-year) and recent (2017-2018) winners determined by GESPC investment per state on a per capita basis. States have until September 15 to [submit](#) GESPC project data for addition to the Race to the Top map and the award presented at the conference.
